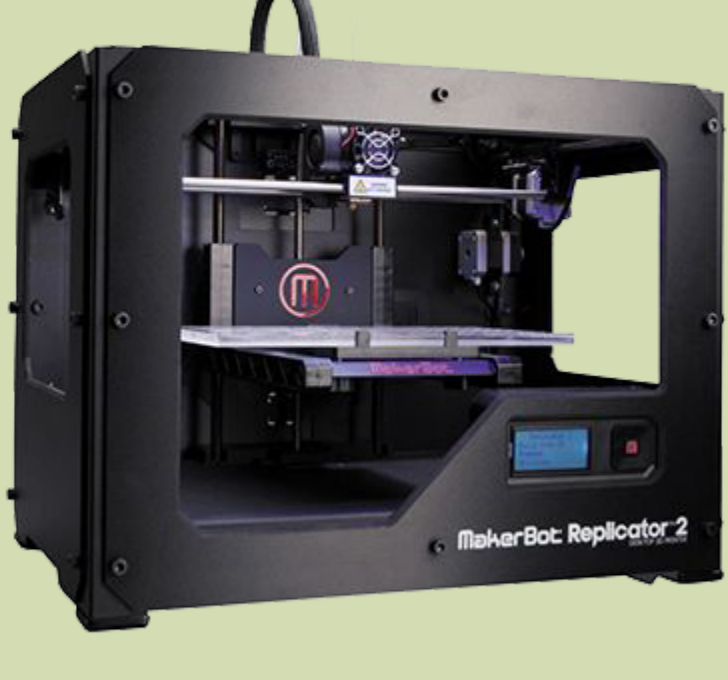

How it Works

- 1** You will need an object to print in a CAD file. All files must end in .stl

You can create a file using a CAD program, such as Tinkercad. Read below for information on beginning Tinkercad classes at the Library.

- 3** Send your request and .stl file to Thea Howes at hzlstaff@gmail.com.

FAQs

When will my object be ready?

Your print job will be printed in the order received. Some jobs ahead of yours may take several hours to print, which could delay your job. We will email you when ready.

How will I know it's ready to pick up?

You will receive an email from hzlstaff@gmail.com when your object is ready to pick up.

Picking up: when and where?

You'll receive an email when your object is ready. Ask a staff member for your object. Our hours are 8:30-7 Mon-Thu, 8:30-4 Fri & 8:30-2 Sat

Why is my object not yet printed?
