

Registration

Give Parents A Break and Parents' Night/Day Out is open to ages 6 weeks to 12 years old.

Registration is complete when the following is on file:

- ◆ USDA CACFP registration paperwork
- ◆ AF1181 (Available at the CDC)
- ◆ Certificate for care or payment of \$30.00 per child
- ◆ Special needs/Allergy paperwork if necessary
- ◆ Current, up-to-date immunization record

The registration deadline will be COB the Wednesday preceding the event.

All registrations take place at the CDC.

If there are 12 or more school aged children, those youth will be hosted at the Youth Center. If there are less than 12 enrolled youth they will be hosted at the CDC.

Cost

Give Parents A Break is free to families with certificates from A&FRC or other wing agencies. Please present a copy of the certificate at registration.

For families without certificates, the cost is \$30.00 per child (payable at the time of registration.)

Cost of care includes meals and beverages. Please notify us at registration if your child has allergies or special dietary needs.

The CDC offers Similac brand of formula. If your infant regularly drinks another brand or if you prefer to bring breast milk, the parents will provide bottles marked with child's name and the time the bottle was made/expressed.

What to Bring

Infants:

- 1 clean bottle for every 3 hours of care and 1 unopened container of formula or 1 bottle of breast milk
- 1 diaper for every hour of care
- 1 container of wipes
- Pacifier, if used

Child not fully potty-trained:

- 1 diaper for every hour of care
- 1 container of wipes

All children:

- 2 changes of weather-appropriate clothing. Outerwear as appropriate for outdoor play.
- Blanket or small stuffed toy for naptime

Allergies and Special Needs

If your child has a special need or food allergies, additional paperwork is required prior to your child attending Give Parents a Break.

Medication

Any medication must have a prescription label and be in the original container. The only exception is over-the-counter lotion or diaper cream.
